**Gillette-Campbell County Airport Reports November Traffic and Offers Holiday Travel Tips**

GILLETTE, WY (Dec. 11, 2012) – Gillette-Campbell County Airport today reported November and year-to-date traffic, as it prepares to welcome December’s holiday travelers. In the month of November, the airport served 4,542 arriving and departing passengers, a 17.7 percent decrease from November 2011, when 5,522 passengers traveled through the airport. Despite the monthly dip in traffic, year-to-date passenger counts are essentially even with last year’s, down by only 1.1 percent versus the first 11 months of 2011.
