Gillette-Campbell County Airport Reports Strong October Traffic

GILLETTE, WY (Nov. 5, 2012) – Gillette-Campbell County Airport today reported traffic results from a busy October; the airport welcomed 5,481 arriving and departing passengers, 4.3 percent more than last year's monthly total of 5,256.

Year-to-date, traffic continues to trend slightly ahead of 2011; through October 2012, 51,643 passengers have traveled through GCC, a 0.7 percent increase from the first 10 months of 2011. Compared with 2010, however, the story is far more compelling; year-to-date traffic is a full 11.5 percent higher than it was two years ago, when the airport served 46,316 passengers through October.

The Gillette-Campbell County Airport is located in Northeastern Wyoming in a major energy producing part of the country known as the Powder River Basin. The Airport sees approximately 62,000 passengers come through yearly and is currently served by Delta Air Lines and United Airlines to Denver, Salt Lake City and Rock Springs, Wyoming.
