Gillette-Campbell County Airport Reports September Traffic

GILLETTE, WY (Oct. 18, 2012) – Gillette-Campbell County Airport today reported September and year-to-date traffic, with both totals nearly even with the same time periods last year.

In the month of September, Gillette-Campbell County Airport welcomed 4,792 arriving and departing passengers, a slight decrease of just 0.8 percent versus 2011's September, in which the airport served 4,831 travelers.

Year-over-year traffic continues to track above that of 2011; September's passenger total brings the airport's year-to-date carriage to 46,162, trending above last year's nine-month total of 46,034.

About Gillette-Campbell County Airport

The Gillette-Campbell County Airport is located in Northeastern Wyoming in a major energy producing part of the country known as the Powder River Basin. Gillette is at the hub of this basin, and the Airport serves the commercial service and general aviation needs for a large portion of this corner of the state. The Airport sees approximately 62,000 passengers come through yearly and is currently served by Delta Air Lines to Salt Lake City, Utah and Rock Springs, Wyoming, and United Airlines to Denver, Colorado. The Gillette-Campbell County Airport and tenants currently employ approximately 260 people in the surrounding area.
