Gillette-Campbell County Airport Reports April Traffic

GILLETTE, WY (May 16, 2012) – A busy year continues at Gillette-Campbell County Airport, where passenger traffic continues to outpace last year's totals, now for four months running.

During April 2012, Gillette-Campbell County Airport welcomed 5,064 arriving and departing passengers, marking a 1.8 percent increase versus April 2011.

Year-to-date, the airport has served 20,321 passengers, a 4.8 percent increase over the first four months of 2011.

About Gillette-Campbell County Airport

The Gillette-Campbell County Airport is located in Northeastern Wyoming in a major energy producing part of the country known as the Powder River Basin. Gillette is at the hub of this basin, and the Airport serves the commercial service and general aviation needs for a large portion of this corner of the state.

The Airport sees approximately 62,000 passengers come through yearly and is currently served by Delta Air Lines, United Airlines and Great Lakes Aviation to Denver, Salt Lake City, and Rock Springs, Wyoming. The Gillette-Campbell County Airport and tenants currently employ approximately 260 people in the surrounding area.
