Gillette-Campbell County Airport Reports February Traffic

GILLETTE, WY (March 15, 2012) – Gillette-Campbell County Airport reported February passenger traffic today and, for the second consecutive month, the airport has outpaced last year's totals.

During February 2012, Gillette-Campbell County Airport welcomed 4,522 arriving and departing passengers, marking a 0.07 percent increase versus February 2011 and a 20.1 percent increase over February 2010.

Year-to-date, the airport has served 9,237 passengers, a 1.2 percent increase over the first two months of 2011.

About Gillette-Campbell County Airport

The Gillette-Campbell County Airport is located in Northeastern Wyoming in a major energy producing part of the country known as the Powder River Basin. Gillette is at the hub of this basin, and the Airport serves the commercial service and general aviation needs for a large portion of this corner of the state.

The Airport sees approximately 62,000 passengers come through yearly and is currently served by Delta Air Lines, United Airlines and Great Lakes Aviation to Denver, Salt Lake City, and Rock Springs, Wyoming. The Gillette-Campbell County Airport and tenants currently employ approximately 260 people in the surrounding area.
